



A neoClassroom Series Course for English Language Learners

Fun and effective English learning for early readers

neoJr+ focuses on the basic framework of English and is designed specifically for young English language learners ages 5 to 10. neoJr+ develops the language base that is a prerequisite for effective literacy development. The course's early emphasis on oral skills, vocabulary, and phonemic awareness is followed up with spelling, sentence construction, and sentence reading exercises.

Course structure

neoJr+ includes 4 levels, each divided into 8 units. The structure of each unit is as follows:

- **Songs** introduce expressions that children will hear and use in everyday English conversations.
- **Vocabulary lessons** present words for people, objects, and activities that are important in children's lives.
- **Grammar** is incorporated through engaging question- and-answer conversations with Sam.
- **Phonics lessons** introduce the names and sounds of English letters, word families, and common English spelling patterns.
- **Songs and Games** introduce and reinforce key language in fun activities.

Sam and Ginger

neoJr+ is based on *Let's Go*, the world's most successful English language textbook series for children, published by Oxford University Press. *Let's Go* features Sam and Ginger, the course's feline guides.

Learners follow the guides on a word-discovering journey around the house, the classroom, the schoolyard and the neighborhood. Sam and Ginger's animated world is bursting with words. Children learn new words while investigating games, food, the weather, animals, etc. As they tour the town on the school bus, they build sentences, sing songs, learn phonics with rhyming sounds, and play a variety of word games.



Kid's Assessment Test

neoJr+'s Placement Test starts young learners in the unit that is right for their current skill level.

Mastery Tests

Artificial intelligence (AI) ensures each student advances to mastery at a pace that is appropriate for them. Then neoJr+'s Mastery Tests confirm a student's grasp of the material within the course. Passing a Mastery Test gives students access to more advanced lessons.

Level Tests

At the end of each level, learners take a comprehensive test covering key language and concepts from the entire level. Learners receive Certificates of Completion aligned with the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* standards.
